recipe for Blue Moon Cafe's
Poppy Seed Chicken!

6-8 chicken breast halves,
cooked and cubed
2 cans cream of chicken soup
16 oz sour cream
2 teaspoons poppy seeds
4 1/2 doz. Ritz Crackers
1 1/2 sticks butter, melted

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
Cook chicken breasts. In a
large bowl, combine sour, sour
cream and poppy seeds. Place
Ritz crackers in a plastic zip
lock bag and crush. Mix
melted butter and Ritz
Crackers. Place chicken (can
be shredded instead of cubed)
in 9x13 casserole dish. Pour
soup mixture over chicken
and top with Ritz Crackers.
Cook for 40 minutes or until
bubbly.
